

M7 Mutiara Motors Amemiya SGC7 maintains pace to ensure another podium finish

TEAM Mutiara Motors Amemiya SGC7 has once again mounted the podium for the third consecutive time at the Fuji Circuit, Japan after the third round of Super GT Race 2009 earlier this week. Drivers Nobuteru Taniguchi and Ryo Orime did an excellent job by maintaining a consistent pace throughout the entire race. Starting at fifth place, Mutiara Motors' car No.7 managed to get to third place in the beginning stages of the race.

In order to catch up with the leaders after lap 30, Team M7 took the same risky move they did in the previous race; to finish the race with the same set of tires after the first pit-stop so that they could save time and stand a better chance of overtaking the leaders. However, due to the big gap between them and runnerup, the strategy of running on the same set of wheels did not pay off, resulting in an unchanged order, with No. 43 in the lead followed by No. 81 in second and No.7 in third.

However, with three podium finishes out of three races, Team M7 Mutiara Motors Amemiya SGC7 clearly has a great chance of grabbing the championship if they can maintain their consistent pace throughout the season.
